These cuts will dismantle Health Home and Care Management Agencies across New York State.

The Governor's Executive Budget proposal will dissipate services to over 180,000 high-risk, high-need adults and children are enrolled in Health Homes. The **\$125 Million CUT** is without a plan to care for or provide further services for the New Yorkers currently served.

The Health Home Care Management population represents the highest risk, high need Medicaid members. This budget proposal would eliminate this service for the following adults and children:

- 77% of those enrolled are BIPOC
- 69% have a mental health diagnosis
- 55% of those in the "medium" acuity are HARP enrolled/eligible with significant behavioral health needs
- 7% are living with HIV/AIDS
- 11% have been Homelessness in the last 6 months
- 16% have a substance use disorder diagnosis

WHAT'S AT STAKE with DISMANTLING the System

Access to Support will be GONE.

- A \$21 Million statewide cut for children and family care management services, due to the negative impact of CANS-NY 2.0 revision.
